**Guadalupe County Fair Parade Guidelines/Information**

Saturday, October 4<sup>th</sup> 2008

12pm Judge 1pm Parade 2pm

Line-up: Information and parade position will be given to the entry at the Seguin High School off of the 1200 Blk of College St. starting at 12pm. Line up by 1pm. Late arriving entries may be denied permission to participate in the parade and will not be judged at 1pm.

Staging area: No vehicles other than parade entries will be allowed in the staging area.

Parents & Sponsors must drop off participants at the nearest intersection closest to their entry.

Parade volunteers will be available for assistance.

Judging: Begins promptly at 1pm sharp! All entries must be in place, set-up & ready to go with riders in position by 1pm. Unit must be decorated and participants must remain in place until all judging is complete to qualify for an award.

Parade Time: Begins promptly at 2:00pm sharp – rain or shine!

Parade Winners: Will be presented with their awards at the announcer stand at central park.

Parade End: Will end at the Coliseum/Fairgrounds. Please pull out of the way of the parade flow to release riders so the units behind in the parade will continue. NO exceptions!

Safety: An adult must supervise all children under the age of 18 participating in the parade.

Liability regulations prohibit and as a safety precaution for our young spectators, we ask that absolutely no items may be thrown during the parade including candy, gum, flowers, coupons, brochures, samples and water balloons. Alcohol may not be consumed or carried by members on the parade route. Water guns may not be used to spray the crowd. Protect yourself & others on your unit from the sun & heat! Roller blades are not allowed on streets along the route during the parade.

Entry Safety: Please maintain a distance of 2-3 car lengths between your entry & the one in front of you. Do not stop your entry along the route unless you have an emergency.

The Guadalupe County Fair Association & parade committee assumes NO responsibility for accidents or loss of any kind.

Music: Playing music too loud is not allowed. The parade official in charge determines “Too loud”. Playing music with vulgar lyrics & profanity is not allowed. Music must be suitable for a family audience.

Limit Vehicle/Equipment: Must not exceed 200 feet.

Equine/Animals: Unit must provide their own pooper-scoopers. If not provided you will be placed at the end of the parade line up!!

Noises: Loud sirens, whistles, etc., are not permitted.

#1: Remember not everyone can be #1 in the parade and not everyone can be “up front”.

Liability regulations prohibit and you will not be allowed to participate in the parade if: registration & waiver forms are not received by the deadline: your entry length is not indicated: each vehicle and animal is not decorated; Alcohol or any illegal substance is being consumed by anyone riding on or driving your entry; you throw candy or any items from your entry; you do not provide proof of negative coggins tests for animal entries; you use water pistols to spray the crowd. Please refer to the Guidelines & information sheet included with this package. Let's be safe & have fun!

The entry fee for all commercial/political units will be \$40.00. Your fee must be paid with a money order or cashiers check. This should be sent in with your registration application.

Waiver, Release and Indemnification Agreement from  
Guadalupe County Fair Association Parade Participants

In consideration of the privilege of participating in the event, I grant to Guadalupe County Fair Association, its successors and assigns, the right to record, broadcast, and otherwise exploit in any and all media throughout the world, my performance in the event and to use my name, likeness, voice and biographical information concerning me in connection with promotion of the event.

For the same consideration, I assume all risks associated with participation in the parade and hereby release and hold harmless all of the following, who are hereafter called “the indemnified parties,” namely Guadalupe Agricultural & Livestock Fair Association, their respective directors, officers, employees, agents, successors, assigns, members & volunteer workers from and against any and all claims, damages, liabilities, costs and expenses, including reasonable attorney's fees, arising out of my participation in the parade, including without limitation, any personal injuries or damage to my property which I may incur as a result of participation in the parade.

I also agree to and shall indemnify and hold harmless all of the indemnified parties from and against any and all claims, losses, damages, causes of action, suits and liability of every kind including all expenses of litigation, court costs and attorney's fees for injury to or death of any person for damage to any property arising out of or in

connection with the event, whether such injury, death or damages are caused by the laws of the State of Texas and that the venue for litigation involving the indemnified parties shall be in court of competent jurisdiction in Guadalupe County, Texas. If participant is not of legal age, the participant's parent or guardian must also sign and date the document.

As Parent or Guardian:

I represent that I am the parent or guardian of the named participant, that I am of legal age and that I have read and fully understand the foregoing Waiver, Release and Indemnification Agreement and that I do agree to be bound by the terms set out above, individually and as participant's parent or legal guardian on behalf of participant, and or respective heirs, executors, administrators & assigns.
